If I am accepted for the Chick Chain Project, I promise to:

- return 4 of my pullets to the Poultry Show and Sale in September
- keep litter (sawdust, shavings, etc. on the floor) and keep the floor dry at all times
- keep feed before my chicks at all times, even after pullets start laying
- keep clean water before my chicks at all time
- not crowd my chicks.

Please Read: For the 2026 show, deposits will be used to solely purchase birds. Monies raised at the sale will be awarded to the 4-H member for their lot of birds. For example: If your 4 birds sell for \$75, the auction will pay \$75 directly to you. By applying for 4-H Chick Chain, I agree to return the previously listed number of my birds (4 per order of 12 or 3 for town option) to the show and sale in September. The sale will take place at 10a.m. but participants will need to be present to check in birds for health testing at 8a.m. Plan to be at the sale until around noon. I understand if I do not return my birds, I will forfeit all monies owed or awarded to me. You may also sign up online using the link or QR code below.
